- Exchange knowledge, learning and information with peers in the sector(s)
- Take ideas back to your own workplace for consultation with your teams
- Create networks and new connections
- Ideas, acknowledgment and feedback for host organisation from attendees

Onsite protocols

Perceived risks by attendees will be mitigated through:

- Compulsory site induction
- Host organisation chaperon(s)
- Code of conduct read/sign/protocols for the host organisation and ShopCare

How do I find out more about Site Visits and when they will be held?

Site visit opportunities will be updated through our Newsletter, Direct Mail, website, LinkedIn and the FGC newsletter. The first site visits will be in Auckland with the intention to have more nationally based on expression of interest.

What type of sites and businesses will be involved?

Site visits will be open to attendees from the following sectors:

- Distribution Centres - supply chain, transport and manufacturing
- Manufacturing sites - supply chain, transport, merchandisers, retail
- Transport Depots - supply chain, retail, manufacturing

How long will site visits last?

Site visits take approximately one hour. Longer sessions may include networking and will be at the discretion of the host organisation.
